
DIRECTIONS: Take Fiske Blvd. to St. Andrews

Center activities are open to visitors who wish to see the judging process in operation or bring their plants to be evaluated. Meeting dates, times, places and contact information are published each month in Orchids magazine as well as on our Events listing.
