






Broughtonia Species

Improvements through **Breeding**







Bro. sanguinea vat. alba 'Mem. Claude H. Hamilton' AM/AOS

Environment

- Warm to hot
- Medium to high light similar to Cattleya's (~50% shade or 2,500-3,500 fc)
- Very good air circulation
- NOT tolerant of over-watering, keep them dry
- · Species like their roots exposed
- Main pests are: scale, mealybug and mites


Pesticides

Potting

- - Species grow best on slabs of tree fern root, cork, driftwood or coconut husk.
 - Galvanized wire, plastic coated wire, party hose to secure plant against slab VERY SECURELY (should not slift).
 Hybrids may be grown in pots in mixes containing bank, shredded tree form and charcoal.
 - Before mounting species, trim ALL roots right back to rhizome.

Broughtonia Hybrids

- Hybrids first produced in Hawaii during the 1950's by late W.W.G. Moir
 First hybrid was Ctna. Rosy Jewel
 C. bowringiana x Bro. sanguinea
 Registered in 1956
